### Two-way Science and Learning on Country

#### Abstract

Two-way Science provides an opportunity for all students to learn about science from the world's oldest continuing cultures. In a Two-way Science approach, schools build partnerships with local Aboriginal communities to develop integrated culturally responsive learning programs that connect the science curriculum to Aboriginal knowledges. The foundation of a Two-way Science learning program is the cultural and ecological knowledge taught by local Aboriginal people to students on country.
